THE DRESSAGE and OBSTATHON WEEKEND on 1st & 2nd of MAY 2010

There is a separate flyer and entry form you can access about the May weekend. The "Freesyle to Music" is to be held Saturday afternoon, May 1st, after the "Rosemont No 1" Dressage competition on Saturday morning.

There will be 4 Freestyle awards :-

THE DRESSAGE AWARD – for the best combination of paces, obedience, submission (this is the horse we are talking about) and music.

THE THEATRICAL AWARD – for the combination of paces, music and dress.

THE BEST DRESSED AWARD – for the best dressed, traditional or fancy dress.

THE ENCOURAGEMENT AWARD – for giving it a dam good try.

To help you put your award winning freestyle together we can video your prepared routine in the arena on either Saturday 20th March or Sunday 21st March. We require you to :-

RING – 4837 3023 to organise a time

REMEMBER – this arena is 20mx60m (the size of a ridden dressage arena) and you must have your freestyle track organised for this sized arena

SUPPLY – your own video camera, or if you need to use ours, we need to talk to you about having something that the video can be transfered onto(at the moment it would be a blank video tape, but this old technology may have been upgraded by this date).

YOU – take this video home and set your routine to music, recorded as a tape or CD

This of course is only one way of putting a freestyle to music together. If you have already put something together you might like to use this weekend to come and see if you need any fine tuning.

THE REEDY CREEK GUIDELINES FOR THIS EVENT

- Judging starts after you have entered and saluted the judge, so it is optional whether you set your entrance to music.
- Transitions do not have to be at the dressage marker letters – it is better they correspond to the music.
- Use it as an opportunity to show off what your horse does best, and minimise those things done not so well.
- If you wish to include a canter movement you may do so, shafting may also be used if desired.
- Fancy dress is optional.
