



## Helmet Requirements

### **ACDS Bylaw 13.12**

*Effective 4<sup>th</sup> March 2016: where helmets are worn at ACDS activities they must comply with at least one of the following codes and its proviso(s):*

*British – PAS 015: 1998 or 2011, VG1 01.040:2014-12 - provided they are BSI Kitemarked*












*European – VG1 01.040:2014-12 - provided they are BSI Kitemarked*

*American – ASTM F1163: 2004a or 04a onwards provided they are SEI marked or SNELL E2001 marked*

*Australian & New Zealand – AS/NZS 3838 2006 onwards and provided they are SAI Global marked*

*Helmet Standard EN1384 will remain in place until 31<sup>st</sup> December 2016. As of 1<sup>st</sup> January 2017 helmets which are certified to EN1384 only, will not be acceptable for use at ACDS activities.*
