GENERAL INFORMATION

Marathon Course / Dressage Arena / Obstacle Cone Driving

With the exception of part of A (which will be on adjoining private land) all competition will be held within the sportsground. The 3 section marathon course will be run on a share stewarding basis i.e., afternoon competitors will steward in morning and vice versa. The course will be approximately 15km and will include 5 marathon obstacles motor vehicles may be used to inspect obstacles but **ARE NOT** to be driven on adjoining private land.

Obstacle Cone Driving will be conducted as a fault competition.

1. This event will be judged under the Rules for ACDS Combined Driving Events effective 1 August 2018 and additional regulations included in this schedule. Particular attention is drawn to compliance with the Code of Conduct for Welfare of the Horse, which is a condition of entry to this event - refer to Article 933.
2. Competitors are aware of, and agree to pay, the applicable excess (currently \$1,500) which applies to any insurance claim against the ACDS Insurance Policy which may arise out of their participation in the event.
3. Appeals together with \$50.00 are to be lodge within 30 minutes of the scores being posted for each phase. Money will be refunded unless, in the opinion of the Appeals Committee, the appeal is found to be frivolous.
4. Entry fee **must** accompany entry form or copy of Direct Deposit receipt.
5. Competitor and groom to be available to steward as per roster.
6. It is the responsibility of competitors to present themselves for inspection, at least **15 minutes** prior to their marathon start time.
7. Dogs must be restrained and must be on a leash at **all times**. This rule will be enforced.
8. No refund of entry fee after closing date without veterinary certificate/doctor certificate.
9. **Right of admission to the Marrar Sportsground is reserved.**
10. **All yards** (own or on site) are to be left cleaned. Wheelbarrow and trailer available.
11. Prize winners who leave early, please organise a friend to collect on your behalf.

Marathon Course / Dressage Arena

The marathon will consist of 3 sections and a total distance of approximately 15km including 5 marathon obstacles. With the exception of part of section A (which will be on adjoining private land) the entire event will be held within the sportsground.

Dressage arena/s will be 100m x 40m.

Obstacle Cone Driving

The obstacle cone driving shall be conducted as a fault competition.

Facilities

Camping on site (no power). Generators are not to disturb other campers and MUST be turned off at 9:00pm. Toilets/showers (no power, bring light). Town water. 31 open yards available (bring something to make a gate) or bring your own yard/s. Electric fence yards permitted.

Catering

There will be no canteen on site during the event. There will be a free welcome BBQ on Friday evening. Saturday night there is a BYO meat BBQ, club supplies salad/vegetables and sweet \$10/person. (See entry form for further information).
