General Information

Dress/Attire:	A Concours'd'Elegance , Class is being conducted during the NSW 2026 GDD Championships, Southern Heat (as per rules 14.3-14.4.) A whip is compulsory and a more formal attire is expected. Approved safety helmets and body protectors may be worn. A Rosette will be awarded the Winner of Concours'd'Elegance being held at the Southern Heat.
Champion:	There will be a Champion and Reserve Champion at each Graded level.
Awards:	As there are two Heats, of the 2026 NSW Dressage Graded Driven Dressage being conducted this year Southern and Northern, the results will be Finalised from both heats and the Overall Winner's will be Declared via a ZOOM presentation post the Final Heat being held by Tamworth Regional Horse Drawn Club at Manilla in November. Awards are for best Aggregate Scores for the Combined Heats. Horse Multiple / Pony Multiple / Horse Single / Pony Single.
Catering:	Tea/coffee/drinks will be available for Free. YES. Sandwiches, cakes etc. can be purchased from the Canteen being run on the Day.
Camping:	Is available – power/showers etc. and MUST be pre-booked (See Entry). Powered site: \$8.00 per night non-powered site: \$5.00 per night
Yards:	Are available Free must be booked with entry.
Dogs:	Dogs are allowed, but MUST be restrained/controlled at ALL times and owners must clean up after their dogs. No dogs are permitted on the Main Arena. Any dog owner that does not abide by these rules will be asked to leave the venue. (Entry money will not be refunded).

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2026 NSW ACDS GRADED DRIVEN DRESSAGE CHAMPIONSHIPS

Southern Heat **Conditions of Entry**

1. This event will be conducted according to the current ACDS Graded Driven Dressage Rule Book and Guidelines dated 1 January, 2025 (**1 January, 2025 Version 4.0**) including State variations.
2. All competitors **MUST** be members of the ACDS. All judges must be selected from the ACDS judge's list, one of which must be an Advanced Judge. (Refer 12.2.2 page 20).
3. **Championship Qualification details MUST be listed on the Entry Form.** ALL horse/s **MUST** be ACDS registered **and to qualify must have competed and completed two (2) Graded Driven Dressage Qualifiers completing two (2) tests as listed at the horse's graded level or one (1) test at the horse's graded level and one test at the level immediately above. (See Grading 5.7.5). Horse/s may compete in any State Graded Driven Dressage Championships held in that calendar year, provided they have qualified. (See Annual Graded Season 6.2).**
4. At State Graded Driven Dressage Championships each horse will compete in two (2) tests, (as listed in the schedule). **The new test in the Championship Schedule will be driven twice.** Horse/s may only compete at the Championship at their graded level. Multiples will be graded per each combination. Grading is taken as at the date of close of entries. Drivers should check the ACDS National GDD Grading List to ensure that the horse/s is entered at its correct level.

5. Singles and Multiples will have separate classes at each level.
6. Subject to Organising Committee approval, competitors may drive more than one combination in the same class.
7. **Awards:** The Champion at each level is the horse with the highest aggregate gained from the two (2) tests driven. At all GDD Championships a whip is compulsory, at Concours d'Elegance presentation A more formal attire is expected. Drivers and Grooms under 18 **MUST** wear approved helmet. Safety helmets and body protectors may be worn.
8. Grooms are optional for Adult Drivers in Single graded driven dressage classes. Pairs and tandems – one (1) groom, four-in-hand – two (2) grooms.
9. Junior Drivers – as per the current ACDS By-Laws. Junior drivers aged 6-7 inclusive must be accompanied in the vehicle by an ACDS adult member (an experienced driving person) seated alongside at all times and holding a second pair of reins attached to the bit. Junior drivers aged 8-15 years inclusive must be accompanied in the vehicle by an ACDS adult member (an experienced driving person) who must be facing forward. Junior Drivers under 18 are not allowed to drive Stallions at ACDS events. Junior Multiple Drivers aged 16-17 years inclusive may drive a tandem or pair or team of ponies and they must be accompanied in the vehicle by an ACDS adult member (an experienced driving person). A Junior Driver cannot drive a horse multiple (pair, tandem, four-in-hand) until they turn 18 years of age.
10. Safety Rules must be adhered to.
11. Helmets are not compulsory in Graded Driven Dressage, other than for Drivers/Grooms under the age of 18. Helmets must comply with the current ACDS By-Law. For all other drivers, grooms, safety helmets and body protectors may be worn.
12. It is the responsibility of each competitor to inspect their vehicle and equipment to ensure that it is safe to proceed with the day's activities. All drivers and grooms compete at their own risk.
13. Competitors are aware of and agree to pay the current excess that applies to any insurance claim, which may arise from their participation in this event.
14. The Organisers have the right to alter any advertised times, refuse any entry with or without stating the reason, or re-allocate a horse or pony to the appropriate class.
15. Only horses on the entry form are permitted to attend, unless prior approval has been received from the Organising Committee.
16. **No fully completed forms NO ENTRY.**

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17. Parents are responsible for their children at this event.
