Through the slopes and plains of Central Riverina

LOCATION 471 Cedar Road Temora, locality 12 km north of Temora on Goldfields Way.
The farm is 5km from the main road.

Join us for 1,2 or 3 days of competitive Enduro Carriage Driving a distance of up to 110km over 3 days for horses, 75 for large ponies and approximate distance of 35 to 45kms over 3 days for small ponies. Weather may vary these distances.

Most routes are on unsealed dirt roads, state forest and a small hill at the start. Returning each day to 471 Cedar Road.

Single day entries for any of the 3 days of events are available for both the Enduro drives & the Pleasure drives.

Daily Enduro ribbons awarded to 3rd place in all 3 classes.

Class 1 Horse over 149cm **Class 2** Large pony over 121cm n.e. 149 cm **Class 3** Small pony under 121cm.

The following rules are for your safety and to make this event successful:

1. All competitors must wear a fluro vest or fluro clothing.
2. While on course please follow All NSW road rules and if necessary move over to the verge of roads to allow traffic to pass. This allows traffic to flow and keeps you safe.
3. Water stops are provided in safe areas off the road. Bring a bucket for your horse.
4. Halter and lead road MUST be carried on your carriage while on course.
5. First aide for Humans in a major case call 000.

7. There are 3 different coloured arrows placed on the course. One colour for each day.
8. Horse Ahead signs are placed at most intersections targeting high traffic use.
9. Have fun and enjoy the drive, keeping the road rules.
