The following rules are for your safety and to make this event successful:

1. All competitors must wear a fluro vest or fluro clothing.
2. While on course please follow All NSW road rules and if necessary move over to the verge of roads to allow traffic to pass. This allows traffic to flow and keeps you safe.
3. Water stops are provided in safe areas off the road. Bring a bucket for your horse.
4. Halter and lead rope MUST be carried on your carriage while on course.
5. First aide for Humans in a major case call 000.

7. There are 3 different coloured arrows placed on the course. One colour for each day.
8. Horse Ahead signs are placed at most intersections targeting high traffic use.
