Conditions of Entry

- 1.All drivers must be current FULL members of their respective clubs
- 2.Junior drivers (under 18) to compete under the current ACDS Junior Driver rules with Hills Club variation ie drivers 6 and under 11yrs must have an experienced adult driver member seated alongside holding a second set of reins.
- 3.All occupants of carriages must wear ACDS compliant **equestrian protective headwear** as per Hills Club regulation.
- 4.The organizers reserve the right to alter the program, according to conditions on the day
- 5.A multiple may compete in its appropriate height group. A groom must be carried with a multiple.
- 6.This is a **one horse/one driver** or **one multiple combination/one driver** day.
- 7.Points towards club & individual scores will be awarded to 4th place, and one point will be awarded to each *other* entry in a class or event.

Bookings are essential for all attendees including drivers, grooms and stewards
