PLAITING A LEAD ROPE – Learn to do some fancy braiding skills with our President Allen Smith .You will need to bring a metal clip and lengths of bailing twine (with no knots) and who doesn't have piles of that?

BARBEQUE TEA – Bring your own meat and the club will supply extras. There will be no other catering during the weekend. There will be free tea and coffee

PLEASURE DRIVE – Heat 2 of the "Texas Holden" card game drive will be held along Shaw Creek Rd. Maximum distance 8km .On returning, cones and obstacles will be available for further practice.

GENERAL INFORMATION -

Be aware the house at Rosemont Horse Complex was burnt down by a woman completely unknown to anyone connected to the place; she was in a very disturbed mental state. The remains have been fenced off and a sign hung warning of asbestos. The area has been sprayed with PVA glue to ensure the asbestos does not become airborne. There are 7 yards available at the open end of the arena, there are two large, under cover stables available inside the arena, two small pony "stables" in a garage and one very small shed which would be ok for a VSE, although they might feel they have been put into solitary confinement.

Parking will be available in the gravelled parking area, and with a very long lead power could be made available to four vehicles. Tying up and harnessing in this area might be difficult, the paddock in front of the burnt down house will be available for parking, sorry no power but you are welcome to put up your own yards.

The weather can be unpredictable so don't forget to pack an extra jumper and rugs for your horse.
