MARATHON COURSE

The marathon will consist of 3 sections, with a total distance of approximately 10km including 5 marathon obstacles. Section A & transfer section will be held on public roads so be aware of the road rules and give way to traffic, these are mostly sealed roads with grassed verges.

DRESSAGE ARENA

Dressage arena/s will be 100m x 40m.



OBSTACLE CONES DRIVING

The obstacle cones driving shall be conducted as a timed/fault competition immediately following your dressage test. Please advise if a change of harness/apparel (eg: swap hat for helmet) is required. All wheel widths will be checked after your cones course is completed.



ROUND 1 STATE OF ORIGIN

If you wish to be part of your state team please tick the box on the bottom of the entry form. All nominated drivers will go into the draw and if numbers are available 6 drivers from each state will be drawn and the best 3 combined scores from each state will go to your state teams score. At the end of the series the state with the lowest combined score will be named the winner of the State of Origin Series 2024. Good luck and have fun!

Round 2 will be held @ Maclagan Qld hosted by the Range Club on 17/18th August 2024.

Round 3 will be held @ Moonbi NSW hosted by the TRHDC held in conjunction with the ACDS NSW CDE Championships on November 9/10th 2024.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. This event will be judged under the Rules for ACDS Combined Driving Events 3rd Edition effective 15 October 2020 and additional regulations in this schedule. Particular attention is drawn to compliance with the Code of Conduct for Welfare of the Horse - refer to Article 933.
2. Competitors are aware of, and agree to pay, the applicable excess which applies to any insurance claim against the ACDS Insurance Policy which may arise out of their participation in the event.
3. Appeals together with \$50.00 are to be lodge within 30 minutes of the scores being posted for each phase. Money will be refunded unless, in the opinion of the Appeals Committee, the appeal is found to be frivolous.
4. Entry fee **must** accompany entry form or copy of Direct Deposit receipt.
5. It is the responsibility of competitors to present themselves for inspection, at least **15 minutes** prior to their marathon start time.
6. Dogs must be restrained and on a leash at **all times**. The Organising Committee will enforce this.
7. No refund of entry fee after closing date without veterinary certificate/doctor certificate.
8. Right of admission to the Kootingal Pony Club Grounds, Moonbi is reserved by the organising committee.
9. **ALL STABLES MUST BE LEFT CLEANED** or **\$50 fine** will be imposed as our club has had to pay \$200 bond on the stables.
10. Prize winners who **leave early**, please organise a friend to collect on your behalf.
11. **THE ORGANISING COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO COMBINE CLASSES AFTER CLOSE OF ENTRIES.**

CATERING

There will be no canteen on site during the event. Free tea and coffee will be available, BYO mug. There is a takeaway shop a short walk from the grounds. This will be a self-catering event with a BBQ available outside the hall and microwave, kettle & stove inside please feel free to make use of it but please clean up after use.. The hall will be open and heated for you convenience and comfort. It will be locked at night.
