MARATHON COURSE

The marathon will consist of 3 sections, with a total distance of approximately 13klm including 5 marathon obstacles. Section A will be held on public roads so be aware of the road rules and give way to traffic, these are mainly sealed roads with grassed verges.

DRESSAGE ARENA

Dressage arena/s will be 100m x 40m.

OBSTACLE CONE DRIVING

The obstacle cone driving shall be conducted as a timed/fault competition. All wheel width will be measured after your cones course is completed.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. This event will be judged under the Rules for ACDS Combined Driving Events 4th Edition effective 1st January 2026 and additional regulations in this schedule. Particular attention is drawn to compliance with the Code of Conduct for Welfare of the Horse - refer to Article 933.
2. Competitors are aware of, and agree to pay, the applicable excess which applies to any insurance claim against the ACDS Insurance Policy which may arise out of their participation in the event.
3. Appeals together with \$50.00 are to be lodge within 30 minutes of the scores being posted for each phase. Money will be refunded unless, in the opinion of the Appeals Committee, the appeal is found to be frivolous.
4. Entry fee **must** accompany entry form or copy of Direct Deposit receipt.
5. Competitor and groom to be available to steward as per roster.
6. It is the responsibility of competitors to present themselves for inspection, at least **15 minutes** prior to their marathon start time.
7. Dogs must be restrained and on a leash at **all times**. The Organising Committee will enforce this.
8. No refund of entry fee after closing date without veterinary certificate/doctor certificate. Unless the event is cancelled by the organising committee.
9. Right of admission to the Kootingal Pony Club Grounds, Moonbi is reserved. **ALL STABLES MUST BE LEFT CLEANED**
10. Prize winners who **leave early**, please organise a friend to collect on your behalf.
11. **THE ORGANISING COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO COMBINE CLASSES AFTER CLOSE OF ENTRIES.**
