LOCATION Wildwood is a property, just off the Newell highway and about 18 km south of Ardlethan.

Join us for 1,2 or 3 days of competitive Mini Endro Carriage Driving a distance of approximately 100km over 3 days for horses and large ponies (classes 1& 2) or 50 kms over 3 days for small ponies (class 3).

Pleasure Drives are run daily after the Endro competitors have left. The drives have views of the Walleroobie Ranges to the east and the Mejum Ranges to the west and are conducted at a leisurely pace through cropping farms. All routes are on unsealed dirt roads and open farmland. Returning each day to Wildwood Farm.

Single day entries for any of the 3 days of events are available for both the Mini Endro drives & the Pleasure drives.

Daily Mini Endro ribbons awarded to 3rd place in all 3 classes.

Class 1 Horse over 149cm Class 2 Large pony over 121cm n.e. 149 cm Class 3 Small pony under 121cm.

The following rules are for your safety and to make this event successful;

- 1. All competitors must wear a fluro vest or fluro clothing.
- 2. While on course please follow All NSW road rules and if necessary move over to the verge of roads to allow traffic to pass. This allows traffic to flow and keeps you safe.
- 3. There are cones on the corner of Matong North Rd and Ardlethan Road. Keep to the left of these cones on the dirt verge as there is no need to go onto the tar.
- 4. Water stops are provided in safe areas off the road. Bring a bucket for your horse.
- 5. Halter and lead road MUST be carried on your carriage while on course.
- 6. First aide for Humans in a major case call 000.
